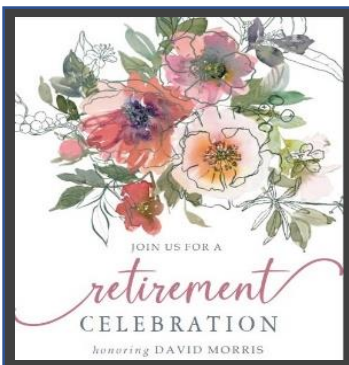
We are here to help in times of need. As Rev. David prepares to leave us, we want you to know that a team of UU members is organizing to meet our congregation's needs.

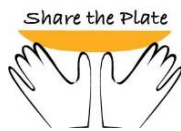
Rev. David's Quote of the Week
